

TRADE STAND REGULATIONS

- 1 Trade Stand Entries will only be accepted if made on an official Application Form accompanied by the fee payable.
- 2 Trade Stand Space will be available as follows: OPEN SPACE £30.00 per metre frontage (minimum size 3metres).
- 3 All Trade Stands must be open and manned from 10.00 am to 5 pm on Saturday 15th August & Sunday 16th August 2009
- 4 Each stand holder will be issued with one vehicle label. Further vehicle labels will be available if needed on request. Vehicles must not be parked in the avenues, or on stand frontages during the hours the event is open to the public.
- 5 There should be no vehicle movement between the hours of 10.00 am and 5.00 pm on both days of the show.
- 6 Exhibitors are only permitted to trade in goods and/or services as described on their accepted entry form. SESHSA reserve the right to reject any application which is not considered appropriate.
- 7 Exhibitors shall not offer for sale for immediate consumption, any food, sweets, foodstuffs, drinks, cigarettes or tobacco without the express permission of the Society. Small samples may be given away, free of charge, for sales promotional purposes only.
- 8 Exhibitors catering or selling foodstuffs on their stands are reminded that they must conform with the requirements of the Food Hygiene Regulations 1970. Officers of the Environmental Health Department of the Local Authority have right of access to all stands during the Show.
- 9 Exhibitors are reminded that the Medicines Act 1968 and the Poisons Act 1972 apply to the display and sale of veterinary products, medicines, etc. All displays and sales must comply with the provision of these Acts, any other relevant Acts and the Rules and Regulations of the Pharmaceutical Society of Great Britain.
- 10 Exhibitors must contain their sales activities to the area allocated and must not block any walkway or avenue or distribute leaflets anywhere other than on their stand.
- 11 Exhibitors may not use any loudspeaker apparatus, engines, or other equipment, participate in any activity or practice, or sell, display or offer for sale any toxic, noxious or offensive substance, article or thing, so as to cause nuisance, annoyance or distress to other exhibitors or to the public.
- 12 All stands will be clearly numbered. Stand numbers must not be removed, defaced or damaged in any way.
- 13 Exhibitors may not commence work on their stand area before Saturday 15th August 2009
- 14 All postholes are to be back filled and the ground/turf reinstated by the exhibitor at the end of the event.
- 15 All stands must be kept clear of rubbish at all times; any rubbish generated to be removed by the Exhibitor.
- 16 All exhibits, mobile units etc must be cleared from the Show site by 6.30 p.m. Sunday 16th August 2009.
- 17 Exhibitors are required to observe all statutory requirements regarding Safety related to their exhibits and their stands.
- 18 Exhibitors are allowed to use their own silent running generators providing they cause no distress or nuisance to others.
- 19 Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of SESHSA, its servants or agents, SESHSA will not be responsible for death, injury, disease, damage or loss caused to any exhibitor or to his or her servants or agents or to any exhibit, animal, vehicle, equipment, plant, machinery, article or thing of whatever nature brought onto the Show site by the exhibitor.
- 20 Save as aforesaid, the exhibitor shall indemnify the Society against all claims, losses, damages and expenses whatsoever in any way arising out of the presence of or the taking part of the exhibitor, his or her servants, agents, exhibits, animals, plant, vehicle, equipment, machinery, articles or other things of whatever nature on the Show site and shall assume full responsibility thereof. Acceptance of this rule shall be a condition of entry or participation in any event, competition or display, promoted or arranged by SESHSA.
SESHA accepts no responsibility or liability whatsoever for any statement or information in any document published by them. SESHSA will not accept liability for any loss or damage (whether direct or indirect) arising from or caused by the abandonment or cancellation, whether total or partial, or the postponement of the Show for whatever reason.
- 21 (a) It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to insure all property on the Show site or elsewhere which is his own, or for which he is responsible.
(b) SESHSA requires exhibitors to effect Employers Liability insurance where this is required by statute.
(c) SESHSA also requires exhibitors to effect Public Liability and Products Liability insurance with a minimum indemnity of £1,000,000 to protect their liability under paragraph 20 and 21 above. Evidence of such insurance to be submitted with application form.
The application form contains a declaration confirming that the cover required under (b) and (c) above will be in place.
